

TUESDAYS

ALGEBRA I (high school level) Tuesdays, 9:00-10:00 AM

Basic algebraic skills, including equations, polynomials, relations, functions, graphing, rational equations, and quadratic functions. TI-83 or TI-84 calculator needed.

AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE 1 *taught by Kiley Brey* Tuesday, 10:00 - 11:30 PM

Learn the basic signs and build vocabulary and grammar. Focus on building communication skills and understanding of the Deaf culture. Qualifies as a high school world language credit. Class fee \$65/month, plus an additional online resource: Goreact video feedback \$66/year membership



FOODS I (suggested age: high school) Tuesday 11:30 - 1:00 PM

Learn the basics of food preparation and nutrition. Additional \$100 lab fee. Curriculum: A Beka Food Preparation and Betty Crocker Cookbook.

BIOLOGY and LAB (suggested ages: high school) Tuesday, 1:00 - 2:30 PM

This course will be an introduction to cellular biology, plants, genetics, taxonomy, microbiology, botany, zoology, and human anatomy from a biblical worldview. Weekly labs as a group. Curriculum: Bob Jones *Biology*, 4th edition and online course (additional \$110/year), plus lab fee.



WASHINGTON HISTORY (ages 13 and up or grades 7-12) Tuesday, 2:30 - 4:00 PM

This course meets the requirement for students to study the history and constitution of the State of Washington. Includes reading, projects, videos, and field trips.

WEDNESDAYS

PRE-ALGEBRA (suggested ages: 11-15 or teacher consent) Wednesday, 12:30 - 1:30 pm
Preparation for Algebra 1, covering fractions, decimals, percent, integers, and solving equations. Curriculum: A Beka Pre-Algebra, fourth edition

LIFE SCIENCE (suggested ages: 11-14) Wednesday, 1:30 - 3:00 PM

Overview of life science: cell structure, plants, animals, and environment from a biblical worldview. Curriculum: Bob Jones Life Science; Online lessons are \$110/year, \$100 lab fee.
