

SALMON CREEK LEARNING CENTER CLASSES 2020-2021

LIFE SCIENCE and LAB (suggested ages: middle school) Tuesday, 11:00-12:30 PM

Learn about cells, genetics, bacteria, insects, plants, animals, human anatomy & physiology and much more. This course is a good introduction to biological science. Weekly classes include labs. Curriculum: Bob Jones *Life Science*, 5th edition and online course (*additional \$108/year*)

Curriculum: *Bob Jones Life Science, 4th edition (additional online course \$108/year)*

CHEMISTRY OF FOOD (high school) Tuesday, 12:30 - 2:30

This class will study the chemical reactions in food. It will cover the foundations in chemistry and apply it to food science. Labs will include basic chemistry and cooking. Curriculum: Bob Jones Chemistry and a food science textbook and lab manual. Weekly labs.

BIOLOGY and LAB (suggested ages: high school) Wednesday, 1:30 - 3:00 PM

This course will be an introduction to cellular biology, genetics, taxonomy, microbiology, botany, zoology, and human anatomy from a biblical worldview. Weekly labs will include microscopes and dissections. Curriculum: Bob Jones *Biology*, 4th edition and online course (*additional \$108/year*)



BASIC MATH REVIEW and PRE-ALGEBRA (all ages) Tuesday, 10:00 - 11:00 AM

Students will review the foundations of math, including fractions, decimals, and percent then move into pre-algebra. Students will move into Algebra 1 as they are ready. Curriculum: Rod & Staff Math, A Beka Pre-Algebra

PERSONAL FINANCE (high school) Tuesdays, 2:30 - 4:00

Learn the basics of money management, budgeting, and beginning investing. Curriculum: Dave Ramsey's *Foundations in Finance for High Schoolers*, Homeschool Edition. Workbook required.

AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE 2 taught by Jill Hofstede Wednesday, 12:30 - 1:30 PM

Level 2 - Builds on the vocabulary and grammar learned in ASL 1. Focuses on building communication skills and understanding of the Deaf culture. Qualifies as a high school language credit.

SEWING Wednesday, 3:00 - 5:00 PM

Learn the basics of sewing or build your skill level, Construct several items and learn to read patterns. There will be a supply list when registering. Materials cost is determined by projects chosen.

Curriculum: *Reader's Digest Complete Guide to Sewing*.
